

2022 Summer Art Show & Sale

The Watertown Art League is pleased to once again offer its members the opportunity to display and sell their art.

When: Show & Sale Display Period: the weekend of June 10 – 12.

Where: At the 550 Gallery and Studio in Bethlehem, CT

Set up is Friday morning (June 10). The racks will be set up at 9 am.

Last Day to Register: Sat. 5/31/2022 (Spaces are limited – Sign-up today)

Deliver and Hang Your Art: Friday from 10 am to noon.

Reception: Fri. 6/10/2022 4 - 7 pm. Refreshments will be available throughout the show but we are hoping the public will be happy to have a summer evening of good food, good company, and fine art.

Pick-up Your Art Sun. 6/12/2022 at the show's closing. There is no storage available so all art must be removed at the show's end. If you cannot be there, please make arrangements with someone else to retrieve your work.

Entry Process

Entry Fee: Membership dues must be up to date plus \$30 for the show.

A commission of 25% is charged on artwork sold during the exhibit. Price art accordingly.

All sales will be handled at the event desk and artists will be compensated after the exhibition has closed. Work may be noted as "Not for Sale" (NFS).

Mediums: All two-dimensional art and pottery. Giclees, copied work, and photography are not accepted.

The Watertown Art League reserves the right to disqualify any painting not deemed suitable for family viewing.

All work must be able to fit onto the league's racks, which measure 3 feet across. The league has 40 racks available and we will notify you how much space you will be allotted after 5/31 when we know how many artists are participating.

All work must be wired for hanging (no saw tooth hangers, D-ring hangers, or easel backs are permitted.).

Work may be rejected for improper wiring. No wet paint permitted.

Liability: Neither the Watertown Art League nor the 550 Gallery may be held liable for loss or damage of any kind. Artists are responsible for insuring their work.

Show Entry Fee and Completed Registration form for this event must be submitted before 5/31/2022.

Other Artist Obligations:

League Member Artists are encouraged to submit a one-page artist statement or bio to be presented in a binder at the exhibit. This should be delivered on the day of set-up. If you have difficulty with this, let us know.

League members are encouraged to submit a digital image of their artwork in an email to **edithreynolds@yahoo.com** prior to the show. The email message should indicate permission for the League to use the image for promotional purposes. This should be done as early as possible so that we may begin marketing the show on social media.

Every participant is encouraged to promote the show on social media. The League will be sending out press releases and there will be a steady stream of online advertising. We hope the show will result in sale of art so let us all pitch in to make that happen.
